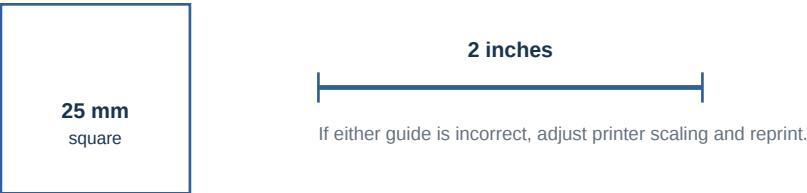


Find Your Ring Size at Home

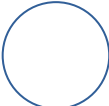

MATCH AN EXISTING RING

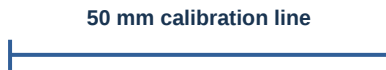
Place a ring that already fits over the circles. The correct size is the circle whose line aligns with the inside edge of the ring.

Cut-Out Finger Measuring Tool

HOW TO USE

1. Print at 100% / Actual Size and confirm the calibration line.
2. Cut around the outside of the strip.
3. Carefully cut the vertical slot marked CUT SLOT.
4. Wrap the strip around the base of your finger with the numbers facing outward.
5. Feed the pointed end through the slot and pull until comfortably snug.
6. Read the US size where the scale meets the slot. If between sizes, choose the larger size.



SIZING TIPS

- Measure when your hands are at a normal temperature - fingers can change size with heat or cold.
- Measure the finger you will actually wear the ring on; sizes may differ between hands.
- For a wide band, you may prefer a slightly larger size for comfort.
- If your knuckle is noticeably wider than the base of your finger, measure both and choose a comfortable balance.
